Who are we?

To see churches in the Majority World equipped for mission and growing to maturity in Christ through the ministry of pastors and leaders who believe, teach and live by the Word of God.

Vision

The term Majority World refers in very broad terms to Africa, Asia and Latin America. It reflects the essential fact that living in these regions are the majority of the world's population and of the world's Christians.

Vision

To strengthen the ministry of the Word of God through:

- 1. Nurturing national movements for training in biblical preaching (Langham Preaching).
- 2. Multiplying the creation and distribution of evangelical literature (Langham Literature).
- 3. Strengthening the theological training of pastors and leaders by qualified evangelical teachers (Langham Scholars).

Mission

The ministries of the Langham Partnership are all based on a set of core convictions, clearly articulated by John Stott and summarised below, which he called the "Langham Logic."

- 1. God wants his church to grow up to maturity.
- 2. The people of God grow through the Word of God.
- 3. The Word of God comes to people mainly (not exclusively) through biblical preaching.

The Langham Convictions

Theological educators must re-centre the study of the Bible as the core discipline in Christian theology, integrating and permeating all other fields of study and application. Above all, theological education must serve to equip pastor-teachers for their prime responsibility of preaching and teaching the Bible. (IIF.4.d)

- Global movement of partners committed to a common vision, mission and values.
- 6 national partners: Australia, Canada, Hong Kong, New Zealand, the UK and Ireland, and the USA.
- More recently, a steadily growing number of indigenous Langham movements are being embraced as full national partners

Books play an essential part in our growth towards maturity in Christ. Yet Christians in the Majority World still have to rely largely on books by Western authors, in English or in translation.








Langham Global Library (LGL)


- Aim: To address contextual issues in the majority world for the benefit of the global church.
- The vision of the global library is to edify believers in their walk with God, encourage Christian leaders, strengthen ministries and develop theological understanding.




Langham Global Library (LGL)




Langham Monographs

Focuses on PhD theses/dissertations by Majority World scholars about theology and biblical studies, written with the scholar's own context in mind




Langham Preaching Resources




Aim: To equip preachers for godliness in character, confidence in conviction, faithfulness to Scripture, clarity in presentation and relevance to their audience.

To publish textbooks, commentaries and researchbased resources that primarily serve the African pastoral and academic markets.





Other Langham Literature products

Langham Literature provides Majority World pastors, scholars and seminary libraries with evangelical books and electronic resources through grants, discounts and distribution.

- Two book programs for institutions in the Majority World.
- The Library Grant Program: an annual library grant, currently of £100.00 at our subsidized prices.
- All Langham books are available on this grant as well as other evangelical theological books from other publishers.

- The list is available in an annual catalogue which is emailed and posted out to member institutions.
- The catalogue can also be accessed online.
- To qualify for this program, institutions must have been operational for 3 years already.

- The Additional Book Program: is for member institutions to purchase books for libraries, courses, faculty, students or alumni at subsidized prices.
- 99% of our books are in e-book format.
- Students, faculty and alumni must go through the central college contact, and pay them for the books they want.

Both programs receive **free shipping** by standard international air mail.
