 Through our partnership with the International Mission Board of the Southern Baptist Convention and New Orleans Baptist Theological Seminary our students can complete 8 courses in two years and receive a Pastoral Ministries Certificate.



8 COURSES REQUIRED FOR CERTIFICATE:

- -Baptist Doctrine
- -Discipling Church Members
- -Evangelism
- -Homiletics
- -Introduction to the New Testament
- -Introduction to the Old Testament
- -New Testament Book Study
- -Pastoral Leadership



 The students are taught by pastors, missionaries and seminary professors from the United States and from other countries who equip and encourage them through short-term teaching assignments.



Our Philosophy

We train national leaders to make disciples of Christ in their own country since they are the best suited to reach their own people. Our prayer is that these new disciples will continue the process and train others to disciple.



Our Results

With the leadership and blessings of our Lord and the support of individuals, churches and other Christian organizations we have been able to graduate over 900 students.



Advance International Schools

Most of our schools are in East Asia.

Since 2011 we have had over 2000 students enrolled in 36 locations with over 500 graduates.

We are presently established in 22 cities and have over 350 students church leaders enrolled.



New Advance Int'l Schools

We are in the planning stages to open new Advance International Schools in Africa, Central America, Dubai, Japan, South America and Thailand.



How We Do What We Do

The main cost for these schools for the students is the tuition costs of New Orleans Baptist Theological Seminary, which is \$25 per course per student for a total of \$200 per Pastoral Ministries Certificate.
